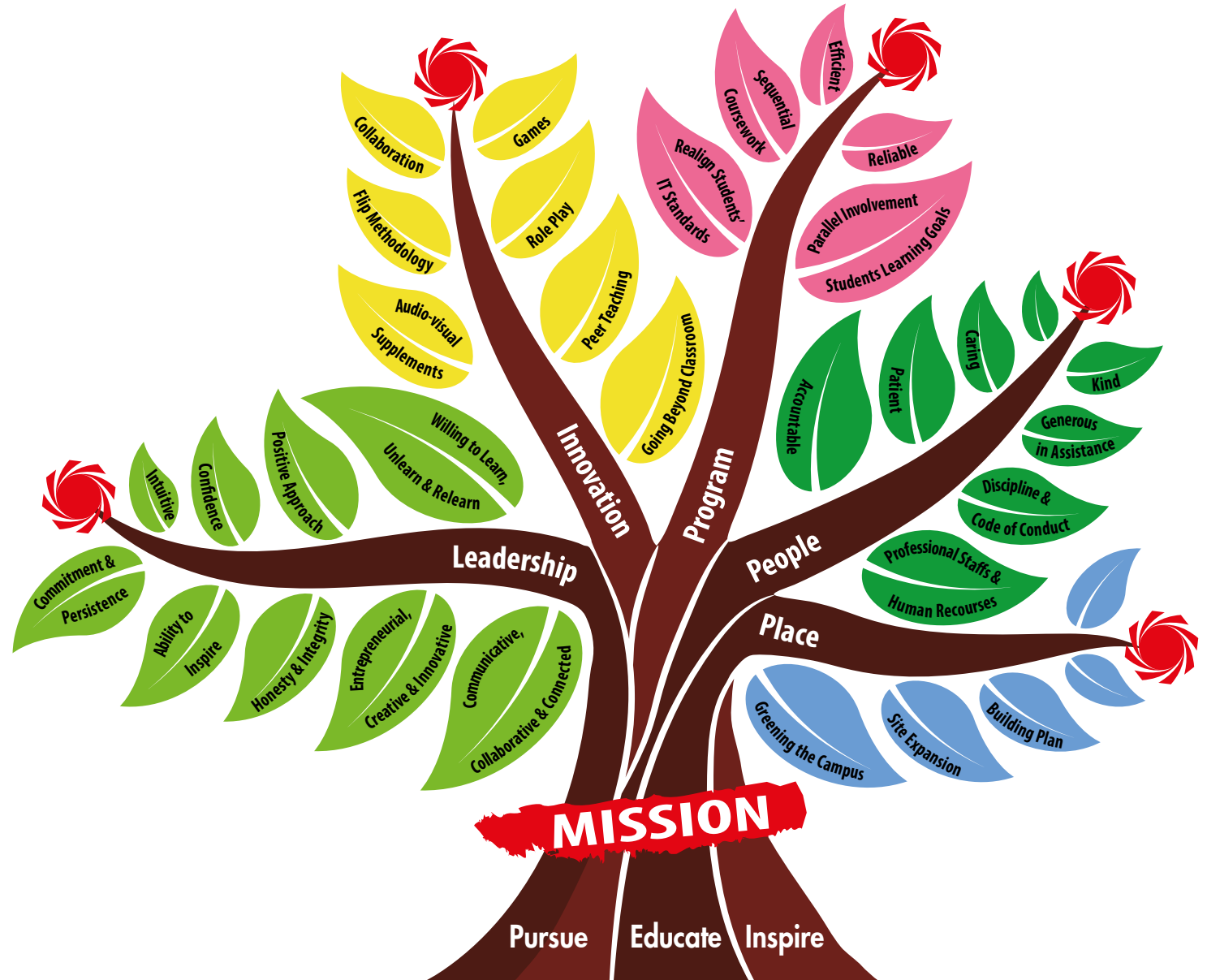

Admission Procedure

The application process includes

- Step 1: Choosing/selecting the subject combination to fill up admission form.
- Step 2: Submitting the admission form.
- Step 3: Sitting on an entrance exam.
- Step 4: Issuing the merit list of eligible students.
- Step 5: Taking an interview for the final gradation.
- Step 6: Processing for enrollment.

Eligibility Criteria

Science Stream

The candidate must have

- passed the SEE (or equivalent) with at least 2.0 in aggregate grade point and must have minimum Grade C+ in Science and Math, D+ in Social Studies, English and Nepali in SEE.
- passed the entrance exam and interview administered by CIA.

Management/Humanities/Law Stream

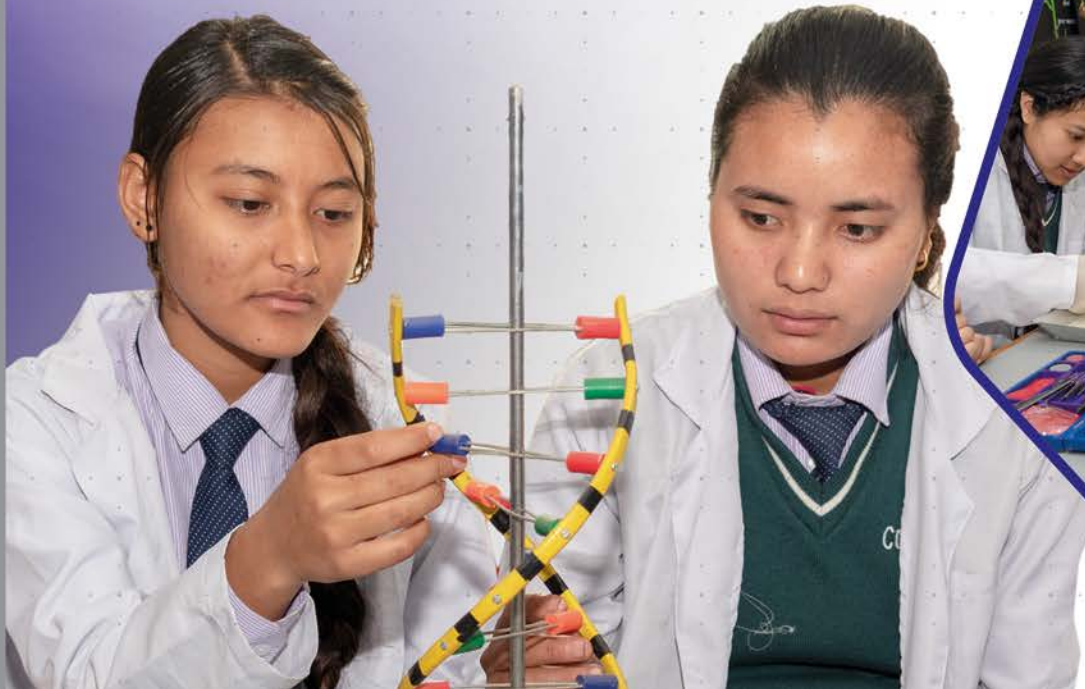
The candidate must have

- passed the SEE (or equivalent) with at least 1.6 in aggregate grade point and must have minimum Grade D+ in all subjects.
- passed the entrance exam and interview administered by CIA.



State-of-Art Facilities

Cosmic has suitable facilities and resources available to the students and provides support and guidance in all areas of students' life.



Science Lab

CIA provides well ventilated, spacious and separate labs furnished with modern and safe equipment for experiments in Physics, Chemistry and Biology. Students are assisted and demonstrated by well experienced teachers and lab assistants at all times.



Hotel Management Lab

HM is a practical based course and self employed field of study so CIA has well-equipped lab with ample apparatus.

Computer Lab

CIA is well equipped with modern computing facilities for students and teachers. Its information technology based learning solutions, multimedia experience, e-resources and high speed internet connectivity are useful instruments for enlarging students' overall knowledge and perspectives.





Spacious Classroom

CIA has spacious, well-ventilated and excellently furnished classrooms with AC and smart boards to make the students learning comfortable and enjoyable. Individual tables and chairs as well as combined desk and benches are provided to students to make them independent and self-reliant.

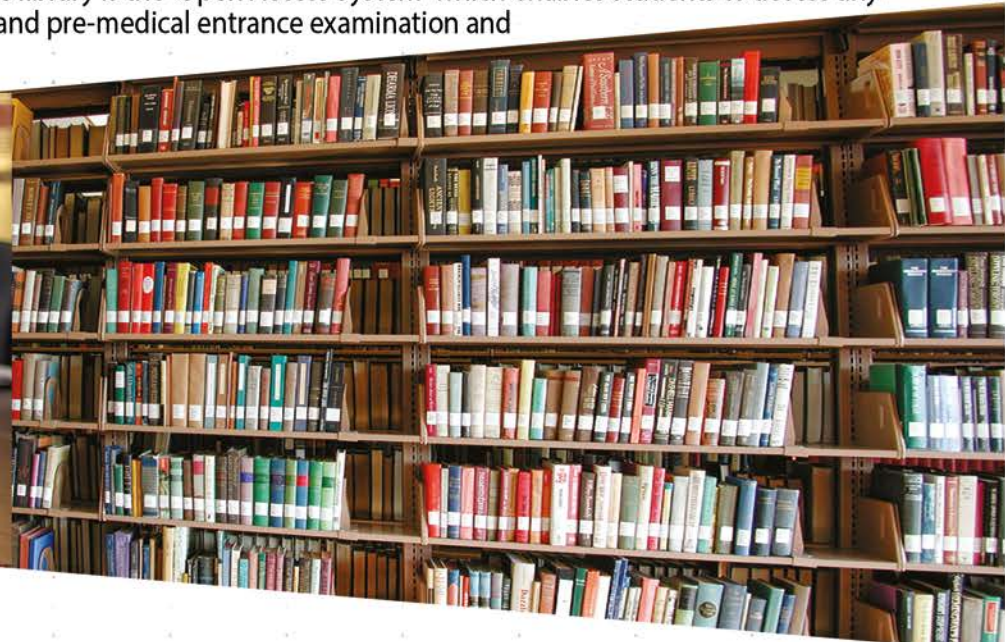


Cafeteria

CIA has a spacious cafeteria. We are committed to provide enjoyable, wholesome, high quality, nutritious meals and food items served in an efficient, friendly manner at an affordable price that the student can afford.

Library

We have a resourceful library. It is enriched with basic text books, reference books, magazines and newspapers. The books have been classified according to the Dewey decimal classification. The unique feature of the library is the 'Open Access System' which enables students to access any book freely. The library also has sufficient material for pre-engineering and pre-medical entrance examination and of course students get the facility of e-library.



Audio Visual Room

The Audio Visual room has a capacity to accommodate about 50 people. It has a wide screen along with a projector and digital audio system. It is not only used by the students but by the teachers as well for in house workshops, guest lectures and seminars.



Presentation & Evaluation

CIA runs different skill oriented program to compete in the global human resource market. We believe that only the lectures and the tutorial notes are not sufficient for the students. So, we have regular presentation classes after the completion of each unit.



Hostel

CIA has well established hostels for both boys and girls separately in the close proximity of the College.



Transportation

CIA provides transportation facilities to its student for easy conveyance to pick up and drop at different places of Kathmandu Valley at affordable fee with its own buses.

Parent Open-House Interactions

Open-House interactions are facilitated for parents in each class four times a year. The purpose of these interactions is to enable a stronger connection between the home and college, and for parents to reflect upon their evolving parenting roles.

Infirmary

Medical facilities are available in the college premises for all minor injuries during college hours. A two bedded infirmary has been set up in the main building to cater to minor/emergency situation. This department is managed by a trained staff.

Exams

Three types of exams are conducted in an academic year: Cycle Test, Tem Exam and Re-exam. All these tests are mandatory for all students.

Term Exam

We conduct three term exams in an academic year. These exams are conducted to evaluate the students progress as well as the hibtuate them to face the NEB final examination. Each exam will follow the NEB question pattern and the time boundary.

In the particular day of the result, the guardians can freely discuss the progress of their children with the concerned subject teachers.

Cycle Test

We runs Cycle Test in every month to evaluate the students progress in the course taught. These tests are conducted on the weekly basis and concerned parents are reported about the progress of their children immediately after the result.

Re-examination

CIA conducts re-examinations targeting the weak students. Those who fail the regular term exams and those who need some more preparations have to appear in re-examination.

Extra Classes

CIA runs extra classes for the weak and needy students. The concerned subject teachers will take the responsibility of conducting the extra classes under the coordination of the college management. The necessity of such classes will be determined by the teachers, guardians, concerned students and college management.

Project Work

Project Work is a central to the experiential curriculum facilitated in CIA. Project work is about asking questions, finding answers, making connections, data organization, thinking open-endedly and drawing inferences. Teachers enable these processes and use them as the tools to assess the children's engagement and knowledge development.



Home Assignment

Home assignments at CIA is mandatory. The assignments are evaluated and graded by the respective subject teachers and finally verified with a college stamp.

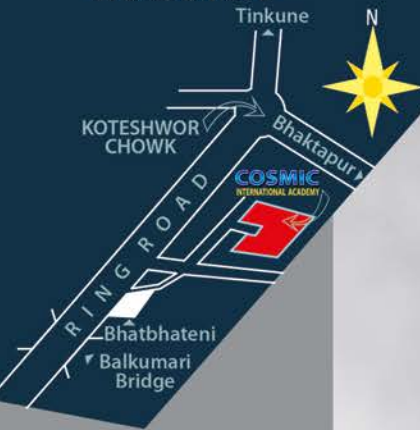
