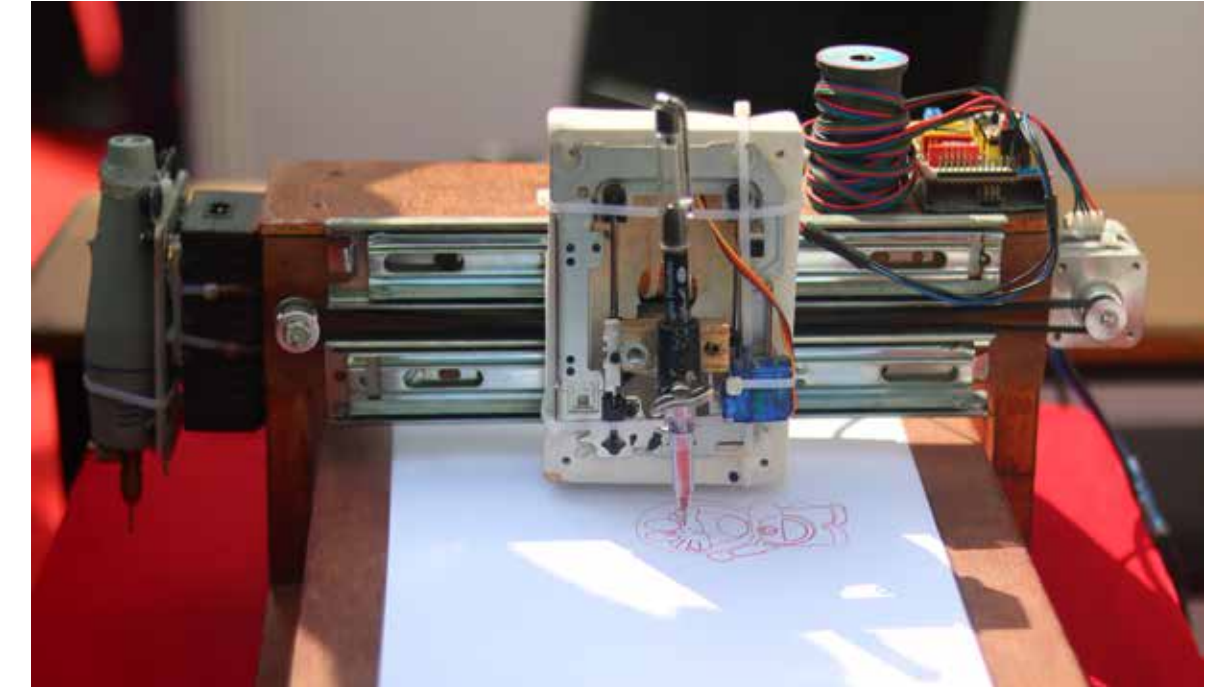
8th National Science Expo - 2019

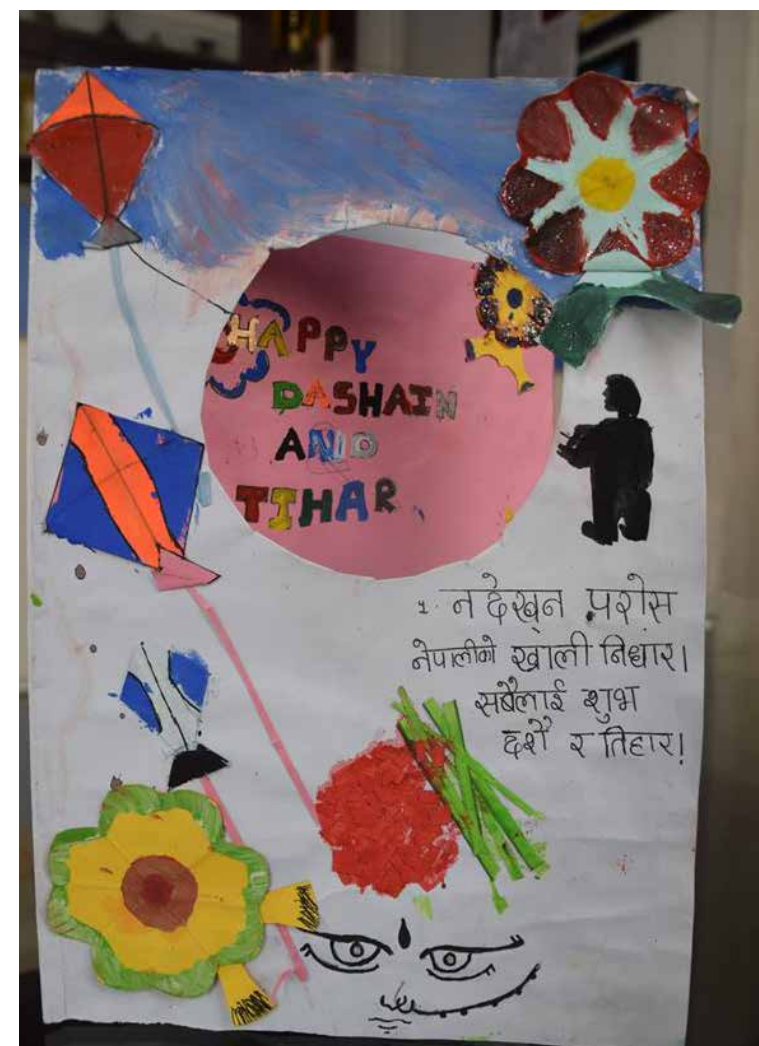

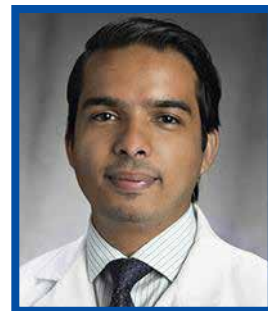
